

OBJECTIVES OF KDEM


- > Promote and support digital industry growth and investments.

Beyond Bengaluru Startup Grid: More than 300 startups connected to the startup grid and facilitated for the registration process on the startup portal, facilitating their entrepreneurial journey.

Policy talks connecting 2,000+ startups conducted successfully for each of the three Beyond Bengaluru clusters.

INVESTOR CONNECT EVENTS IN 3 CLUSTERS OF BEYOND BENGALURU

In a first of its kind, structured investor connect events across the three Beyond Bengaluru clusters of Hubballi (Oct 5), Mysuru (Oct 25), Mangaluru (Oct 29) and Belgavi (Jan 5) connecting 5,000+ delegates, 125+ speakers (Who's Who from the industry), and 13+ MoUs conducted towards various panels pertaining to the Digital Economy (FinTech/ESDM/ Cyber Security/ AI) and road-mapping strategy for Beyond Bengaluru.

INVESTMENT PITCH FOR SETTING OPERATIONS BEYOND BENGALURU

Within 9 months of being operational, pitch made to 30+ companies for setting operations in Beyond Bengaluru clusters. Of this, 11 companies have already started their operations, with some quick successes including IBM (employment 250) & Glowtouch (employment 300) setting up their Global Delivery Center in Mysuru; companies like I-Merit (employment 150) being grounded for its operations in Hubballi. Employment for 2,500+ people has been created. Additionally, 8+ companies are in pipeline for starting their operation from the Beyond Bengaluru clusters.









KNOWLEDGE DISSEMINATION SERIES

Knowledge Dissemination Series: Cyber Security conference conducted for Mysuru cluster with speaker representation from RAW, Tel-Aviv University, industry leaders from companies like Deloitte, entrepreneurs in the cyber security space and so on; the participation in the event was more than 400 people.

LAUNCH OF 2 EMC CLUSTERS

Launch of 2 EMC clusters in Mysuru & Hubballi (230 acres each). Out of 230 acres, LoI received from 7 companies worth 90 acres for Mysuru and 11 LoIs received for Hubballi, for a total of 70 acres.

INVESTMENT OF TECHHERN BATTERIES PVT. LTD. WORTH INR 1,000 CRORES+ IN MYSURU

Facilitated the investment of Techhern Batteries Pvt. Ltd. Worth INR 1,000 crores+ in Mysuru for setting up Li Ion battery plant employing about 400+ people.

DID YOU KNOW?

KDEM has piloted the Beyond Bengaluru initiative with Mysuru, Mangaluru and Hubballi clusters and 3 more are on the way.



- It is estimated that by the year 2030, the cities Beyond Bengaluru would be contributing USD 10 billion towards the IT industry, having employment potential of 10,00,000 people and establishment of 10,000 startups.
- Some quick results with companies of the like of IBM (employment 250) & Glowtouch (employment 300) setting up their Global Delivery Center in Mysuru; companies like I-Merit (employment 150) being grounded for its operations in Hubballi. Within the first 9 months, 15 companies have started their operations from the Beyond Bengaluru clusters creating employment for 10,000+ employees.
- The Beyond Bengaluru cluster seed fund for Startups will be established in Mysuru, Mangaluru and Hubballi on the lines of cluster managed by KDEM at an expenditure of INR 20 crores and INR 12 crores will be provided for the project in the current year.
- The cities Beyond Bengaluru are foreseeing greater investment opportunities and employment potential.
